Did you Know Evansdale Elementary School:

- Has over **500 students** from our community enrolled from Pre-K through 5th Grade
- Is a feeder elementary school into Henderson Middle School and Lakeside High School.
- Is a Title 1 School; more than **40% of our students are economically disadvantaged**
- Is **STEM Certified** in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math
- Is a **French Immersion** School where students receive 50% of their daily instruction in French and 50% in English; a highly sought after program within DeKalb County
- Is the First and only **dual STEM Certified/French Immersion** school in DeKalb County, GA.

Did You Know that thru Eagle Trek:

- Evansdale students collectively walk hundreds of miles to raise funds to support their school.
- Our Community has been able to provide:
 - Stipends to support teachers' Gifted and/or ESOL certification
 - 40 Chromebooks + charging table to improve ratio of students to laptops
 - An overhaul of the school media center turning the space into a 21st century library
 - Seesaw, a school-wide communication and student portfolio platform
 - Little Sponges (K-2) and Savio (3-5), French Dual-Language Immersion online tools
 - Support for French Immersion Intern to support Dual Language Teachers
 - Support for classroom field trips extending the classroom beyond Evansdale
